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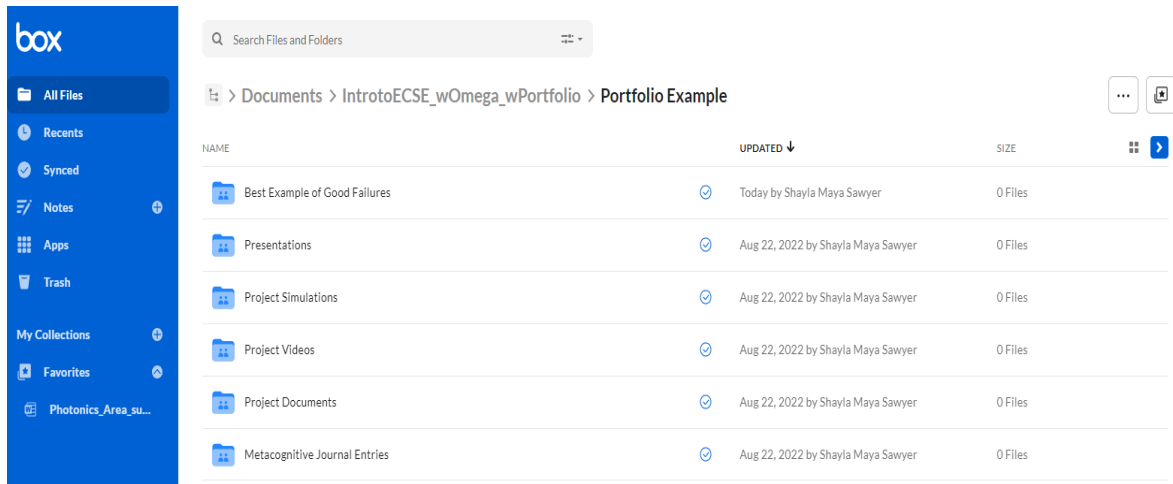
Why a Portfolio?

It's much more than a GPA. It's BETTER than just a GPA. ***You can demonstrate to future employers or research groups EXACTLY how you've applied your learning in your classes.*** The ECSE curriculum has multiple chances to decide to do open-ended design problems that demonstrate mastery of a skill or concept. The ECSE department and ECSE Advisory Board made up of Industry Leaders and Leaders in Academia all agree that your portfolio is a good way to show your progression of learning! Soon, the ECSE department will help you align skills that various employment/research opportunities are looking for! We hope to create a searchable database for employers/research groups to find you and the work you've done to learn throughout your curriculum and especially in your core ECSE classes!

 - Bonus: A good failure that explores a concept you haven't learned yet
