- What's my favorite LED color?

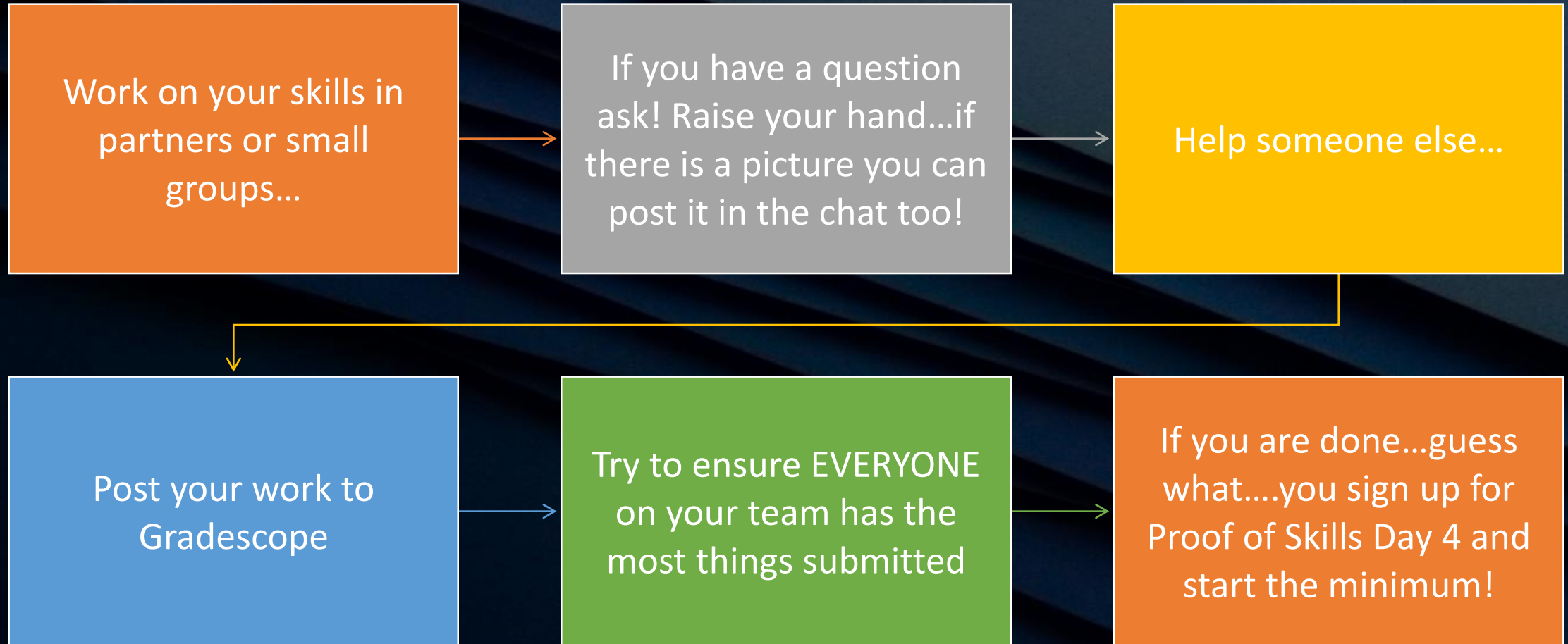
